





Percentage of male workers employed in each economic sector




## Employee Fatalities: Coal Mines and Railroads Annual Number Killed at Work



Per thousand population




The Shortening of Men's Working Lives

### **Work Hours in Manufacturing**


Average hours per week for full-time workers




#### **Labor Force Participation of Women**

Percentage of each group in labor force













# Attitudes toward Married Women Working Percentage of respondents





Percentage of each profession




Black Physicians, Lawyers, and Engineers
