

Getting *R* running

Economic growth: Theory and Empirical Methods, UC3M

During the practical classes, we are going to use the computer language *R*. To install it, go to the following [link](#) and follow the instructions for download. Afterward, install the program. You have separate versions available for *Windows*, *Mac OS*, and *Linux*. The program just provides you with a library of codes but not a visual interface, or Integrated Development Environment (IDE), to call those codes. There are different IDEs available for *R*, and I will use *R-studio Desktop* which I recommend to you as well. When opening *R-studio* the first time, it will ask you which version you want to use. Here, you have to select whether your computer runs a 32-bit or 64-bit operating system.
